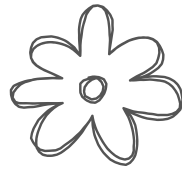
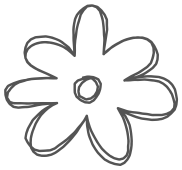


Dedicated to Mrs. Judy Penner
